229. STUDENT FUNDRAISING	
1. Purpose	The Board acknowledges that solicitation of funds from students must be limited because compulsory attendance laws make the student a captive donor and such solicitation may disrupt the educational program of the schools.
2. Definition	For purposes of this policy, student fundraising shall include solicitation and collection of money by students in exchange for goods or services or as a contribution for charitable purposes.
3. Authority	The Board prohibits the collection of money by a student for personal benefit in school buildings, on school property or at any school-sponsored activity. District students are not obligated to conduct door-to-door sales for fundraising activities.
4. Delegation of Responsibility SC 511	Collection of money by approved school organizations may be permitted by the building principal. Collections by students on behalf of school organizations outside the schools may be permitted only by the Superintendent. The Superintendent or designee shall develop administrative regulations to implement this policy. The building principal shall distribute this policy and relevant procedures to each student organization granted permission to solicit funds.
