706.1. DISPOSITION OF SURPLUS PROPERTY	
1.Purpose (3260)	The Board recognizes that surplus property may have to be disposed of because the property is obsolete, unusable, not needed, or that the storage cost outweighs the value of the property.
2.Delegation of Responsibility 706.1-AR	The Superintendent shall create an administrative rule which provides for the disposition of surplus property in a manner which provides an opportunity for residents of the district to purchase or obtain the property, guards against potential abuse, and maximizes the financial return to the district.
3.Guidelines	Members of the Board and the school district staff may purchase or obtain the property on the same terms as members of the public at large.
