Guide	NAMING OF SCHOOL DISTRICT FACILITIES	Reference
Purpose	<p>The Board of School Directors recognizes that from time to time the community may wish to name a School District facility in honor of an individual who has been an extraordinarily positive influence within the School District. It is the intent of this policy to establish the criteria and procedures to be used in these circumstances.</p>	
Definition	<p>School district facility shall refer to any building, space within a building, field, playground, or other property owned by the District.</p>	
Policy	<p>The Board of School Directors shall consider requests by individuals or groups within the community of Springfield Township to dedicate a School District facility in the name of one or more individuals whose contributions to local public education satisfy the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A contribution which is extraordinary and unique and which serves as an exemplar to those within the School District. 2. A contribution which is recognized by students, parents and staff as having an extraordinarily positive influence on the lives of students. 3. A contribution which has created and supported positive links between the schools and the community. 4. A contribution which has taken place over a significant period of time. <p>The Board reserves the right to consider dedication of School District facilities in the event of special circumstances not presently defined by this policy.</p>	
Procedure	<p>The Superintendent shall receive nominations and all pertinent information needed to evaluate a candidate. The President of the Board shall appoint a committee who, with the Superintendent, shall review the information and report its findings to the Board which shall make a final decision.</p>
